We have planned an interesting and educational tour focusing on **Stewardship of Ag land in Nevada County** *Save the date -May 15th*

Visit Several Working Agriculture Locations in Nevada County...

- 🌱 Our first stop will be **Weiss Brothers** commercial growing grounds in Cedar Ridge. Learn the history of their growing grounds and share their delight in celebrating the 50th year in business. Touring the greenhouses bursting with locally grown flowers and vegetable starts is sure to be beautiful and educational.
- 🌱 Then to a **Nevada County Resource Conservation District** site where a prescribed burn demonstration will show the benefits of prescribed burning as a tool used for good land stewardship. Low intensity controlled burns can improve defensible space, clean up forest debris and restore forest and soil health.
- 🌱 Next stop will be **Super Tuber Farm** – Jeremy Mineau of Super Tuber Farm aims to produce the tastiest, high quality organic food in a manner that enriches the soil in which it grows, the hands of those who grow it, & the bellies of those who eat it.
- 🌱 Lunch Stop will be at **Rollins Lake** - About ninety percent of all the water delivered by NID is for agricultural use giving life to approximately 32,000 acres of irrigated land in Nevada and Placer Counties. We will hear an update on the plan for water process which includes a review of NID's available water supply and the long-term impacts on varying water demands.
- 🌱 Finally **Montoliva Vineyards and Winery** – Mark Henry is the owner, vineyardist and winemaker. Julianne Henry's official title is "Wine Muse", a designation that belies her efforts at keeping things under control. Together, they welcome the opportunity to walk you through the vineyards, fountains, herb garden and, of course, tasting of award winning wines at the winery..
